Venue

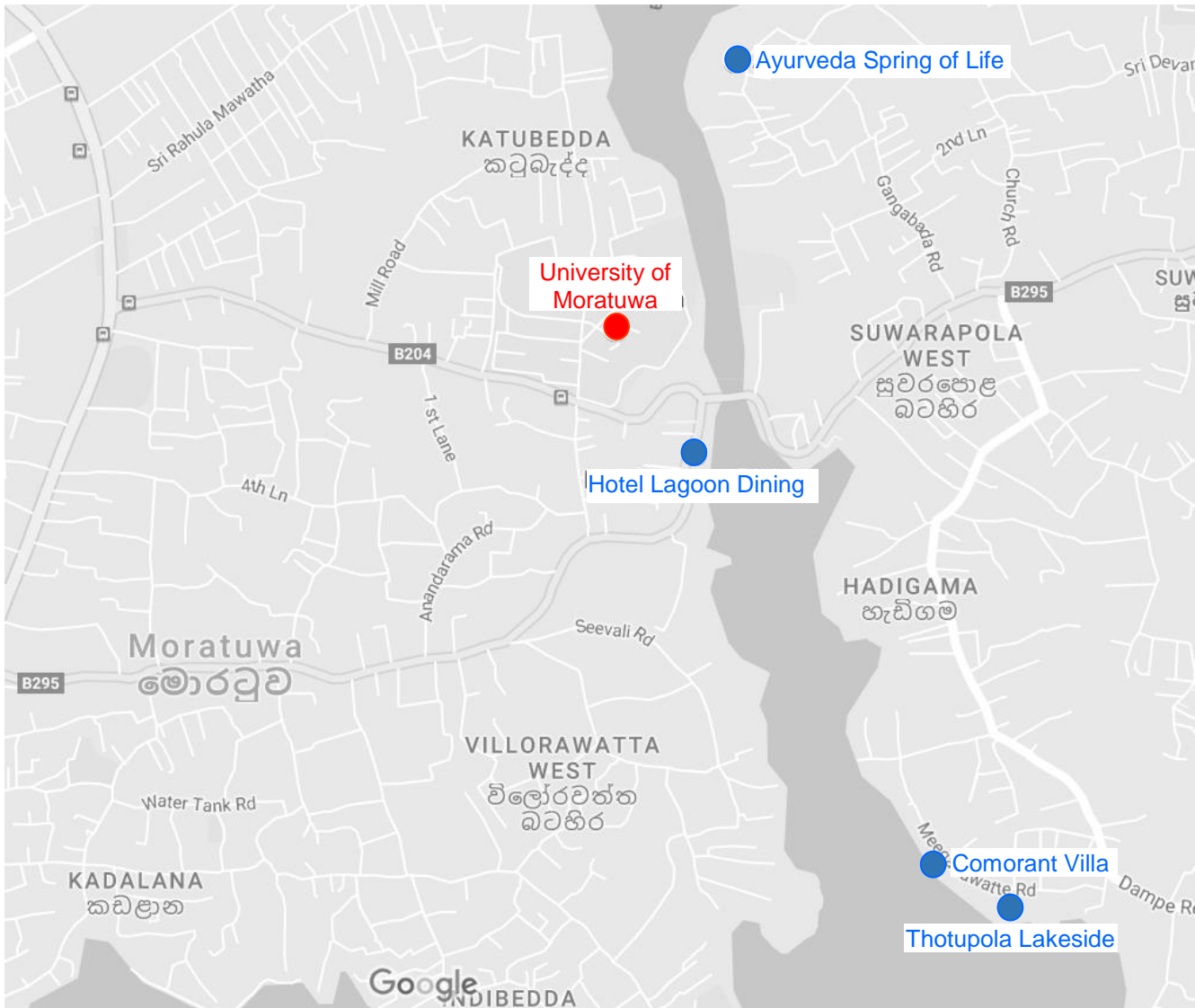
The proposed venue for FOSS4G-Asia 2018 is University of Moratuwa. The University of Moratuwa is the only technological University in Sri Lanka and ranked as the most sorts after University in Engineering. The University of Moratuwa is located 10 minutes away from the Moratuwa city and one hour away from the capital city of Sri Lanka, Colombo. The University of Moratuwa is one of the pioneering institutes in geo-spatial sciences in Sri Lanka. We have been actively involved in and part of FOSS4G community since 2014 (<http://osgeolab.sliit.lk>). We have established a FOSS4G lab at the Department of Town and Country Planning, University of Moratuwa. There is a growing interest among researchers, academics, University students, state national urban planning authorities and non-governmental organization to use open source GIS technology. Further, FOSS GIS tools are being used to analyse and solve real issues in Sri Lanka (flooding, draughts, landslides, etc.). In this backdrop, FOSS4G is a timely event to popularize and consolidate FOSS4G technology and provide opportunity for local researchers and practitioners to share and be exposed to international researches' experiences on this field.
