

Carlsbad and Moser – glass-house with museum

All-day event (9 hours) with guide

Karlovy Vary

This spa, about 105 km far from Prague, is the oldest, largest, and the most important spa in the country. Since the 14th century, when the emperor Charles IV founded the town Karlovy Vary, the springs have been used for balneological purpose. Numerous famous personalities from around the world were cured here, among them the greats like Mozart, Goethe and Karl Marx.

Another interesting site to be visited in Carlsbad is glass factory Moser which provides longer than 150 years history of traditional glass production with more than 2000 exhibition pieces.

Jewish Quarter – Josefov

Jewish quarter in Prague represents the best preserved complex of Jewish relics in Europe. It was founded in the 13th century.

Old Town Square

It is the most important square of the historical Prague. It was founded in the 12th century and witnessed any historical events.

Old Town hall with Astronomical clock

It was established in 1338 as the seat of the self-administration of the Old town. The oldest Gothic part of the complex with tower, bay chapel and rich emblem decoration date back to the second half of the 14th century. In upper part of Astronomical clock appears each full hour twelve apostles and in lower part, there is a calendar board with zodiac signs by Josef Manes (1856).

Central Bohemia tour – The Konopiště castle and Kutná Hora

Konopiste



Originally a Gothic castle in French style modified in the first half of the 16th century. During modifications around 1750 the large hall's ceiling was decorated with a fresco Four Seasons by F. J. Lux and marble fireplaces with carved adomments by L. Widman were installed. A reconstruction of the castle in the years 1889-1894 was carried out by J. Mocker. A landscape park was established around 1900. The famous d'Este armory on the third floor of the castle including an extensive collection of historical weapons and armory came into existence by joining a former armory of the Italian family Obizzi and works belonging to the d'Esté and Habsburg families. Representative historical interiors. Interiors containing objects collected by the Crown Prince F. F. d'Esté /armory, library and chapel/

Kutna Hora

Thanks to the prosperous silver mines, Kutna Hora became after Prague the second most important town of the Kingdom of Bohemia on the Middle ages. There are many unique Gothic monuments in this town, especially St. Barbara's Cathedral (1388–1565), one of the most beautiful structures of the Czech Gothic, then Italian Court with Royal mint, where the famous Prague groschens were coined, Stone House, Church of St. James, etc. At nearby Sedlec, it is possible to visit the Ossuary. Kutna hora is on the UNESCO list of World Cultural and Natural Heritage.



Karlštejn castle

The most significant medieval castle, built in 1348-1355 under the rule of Charles IV for the purpose of safekeeping the crown jewels and state documents. In the 16th century, it was reconstructed in the renaissance style and altered in pseudo-Gothic style in the late 19th century. In Holy Rood chapel we can find a unique collection of 1320. Gothic tabular paintings by Master Theodorik from 1360. The castle is situated 40km south-west of Prague.
